EDITORIAL COMMENTS

It is my sad duty to inform readers of two great losses to the Hartwell family which have recently taken place.

In December of 1967, our great friend and cousin John F. Hartwell died. While we had never met in person, through the years our correspondence bound us ever more closely together. It is no secret that to John we owe a tremendous debt of gratitude for the production of the Hartwells of America, which first appeared in 1958, and also the first Supplement to the Hartwells of America, 1962. His work in compiling the records of the Hartwell family and in up-dating the work of Lyman Densmore (Hartwell Genealogy, 1636-1887) will forever stand as a testimonial to his efforts—ceasing only in death—to record the history of our family. We are all very proud and grateful for this legacy which John has left for us. We hope that our own efforts will amount to half the great work he performed.

We were also saddened to learn of the fire which swept through the historic Hartwell Farm House which virtually leveled the 2 1/2 story building.

Fire Chief Leo J. Algeo of Lincoln, Massachusetts, has called in the fire marshal to investigate the cause of the general alarm fire. Firefighters were alerted by the owner, Miss Marion Fitch, who lived in the second floor of the house. Firefighters arrived to find the entire back of the building engulfed in flames. The structure is within the Minuteman National Park.

In addition to almost complete destruction of the main building,

three interconnecting structures, originally farm sheds, were destroyed. Only the front remains standing and it is problematical whether it can be repaired.

During the Revolution, on the night of the famed ride of Paul Revere, April 18-19, 1775, Dr. Samuel Prescott, who rode with Revere, went to the farm of Samuel Hartwell to alert him of the British march on Lexington and Concord.

Samuel Hartwell, a gunsmith, dressed and joined the Lincoln Minutemen while the rest of the family raced down the road to warn Captain Smith. Revere had been captured earlier in the night in Lexington but Prescott, who had been visiting his girl friend in Lexington, broke away from the British patrol and subsequently went on to Concord.

It is related that Mary Flint Hartwell, Samuel's wife, asked Sukey, their negro slave, to run down the road to Captain Smith's to tell him about the British. It was a moonlight night and Sukey was frightened of the shadows, so Mrs. Hartwell asked Sukey to hold the baby and she would go. Mary rushed down to Captain Smith's to warn him and returned quickly to get an early breakfast for her busband. After he left, Mrs. Hartwell and Sukey milked the cows and turned them out to pasture. Then Mrs. Hartwell sat quietly at home with her children to await the return of her husband, but Sukey dashed into the woods back of the house and was not seen until the next day--long after the battles were over.

Mr. Hartwell was a gunsmith and his house was to have been burned, but when the British returned from Concord, they were in too much of a hurry to stop. One soldier put his bayonet through a front window and Mr. Hartwell found the gun when he returned, repaired it, and used it for hunting.

John Hartwell, who was born in 1848, was the last member of the family to live in the farm house.

In this number we print the remaining reports of English parishes searched for Hartwell material received to date. This brings us up to date on the Parish Register and Bishop's Transcript material received from our valuable searchers in England. A list of those searchers contributing to this number will be found at the end of this number.

Complete Copy of Marriages taken by H. I. Longden who remarks that he found more marriages in the Bishop's Transcripts than in the register. 1660 to 1754 only in the copy. Burials 1660 to 1797 and Christenings 1660 to 1795 extracts only.

As King's Sutton was a Peculiar there are no Bishop's Transcripts at Delepre Abbey. A very few early 17th century years are at Lincoln, and from 1736 to 1812, and the single year 1839, are at the Bodleian, Oxford. No Hartwells were found in the above Marriages or in the extracts.
