

Herewith the complete list of all the HARTWELL/HARTLE, etc. Wills which are in the County Record Office at Worcester.

You will note that there are very few Wills listed under the HART-WELL spelling and this suggests the family were not in Worcestershire for very long. It also means we have no positive clues where to start our searches and the best bet would seem to be to eliminate all the 11 parishes within the City of Worcester itself, particularly as all the original registers are now in the County Record Office.

Another factor which must have an effect, is that there is a parish named HARTLEBURY in Worcestershire, and this suggests that some of the HARTLE families may have originated in this area, and will have no connection with the Hartwells.

There is no record of the name in this period.

This parish is now in Liecestershire, but was at one time in Note: Derbyshire.

PARISH OF KINGSBURY, WARWICKSHIRE, TRANSCRIPTS AT BIRMINGHAM. Photostat copy of Registers, searched by John Coker, 28 February 1968.

The Kingsbury Registers were in a very bad state when they were rescued from a pool of water in the bottom of the Church safe. They have been repaired and a photo-stat copy has been made.

Unfortunately, the pages at the beginning of the register are illegible from 1537 to 1562.

Most of the other pages -- up to 1679 -- are also imperfect and there are illegible parts on many of them.

Wishes to be buried in the Churchyard at Baginton. To my son, Richard and daughters Elizabeth, Jone, Mary -- everyone of them my children -- a cowe a piece. To Henry, my wyffes son--a shepe. To the Poor of Baginton, 3/4. To the repair of the church, 12d. Request my brother, James Hartwell, to have my daughter Jone, to live with him until she is of marrying age, if he will have her. Mentions WILLIAM (?) REDE, my wyffes brother. Sole Exor: Ellen my wyffe.

Signed 3 May 1564 Witnesses: ROGER DUNTON; RICHARD DUNTON; THOS. WELDAYLE; PETER MORE.

Inventory taken 30 July 1564 by THOMAS WYNNE, gentleman, JAMES STAF-FORD, ROGER DUNTON, values goods at £2.5.7.

### Will of Christopher Hartwell, of Tamworth, yeoman. Proved 24 Mar 1740/1

To my wife, Anne, all my real estate lying in Tamworth, Bolehall, Amington, Glascott, which I purchased from Thomas Newbold. £50 apiece to my daughters Mary and Ann, and £100 to my son Thomas on the death of my wife. Residue and Sole Exor: Wife Ann.

To JAMES PALMER, £5 to buy a ring.

Resudue to Mary SANDLES.

Exors: JAMES PALMER, WILLIAM SANDLES.

On 30 Nov 1829 the Will was resigned and sealed by Mary Hartwell in the presence of REBECCA HART; JOHN COPE; WILLIAM GILL.

Note: It would seem that Mary Hartwell must have acquired more property since the Will was drawn up, as all the property mentioned above is within the Lichfield Diocese.

From the list of Wills previously given we noted that this parish figured prominently in connection with the Hartwell name, and it was therefore thought that the registers would be well worth searching. Unfortunately, these Parish Registers have never been copied and are still at the church. We have no alternative -- for the time being -- but to search the BT's, and we have covered the period 1751 to 1840, and have certainly proved that the Hartwells were well established in this parish.

Unfortunately, these BT's leave much to be desired, and many of the early baptisms do not give the names of the parents, which makes it impossible to identify any child. The search was stopped when we got back to 1751, as the transcripts were getting more and more unreadable, due to bad handling and damp, in the days long ago. We are hoping that we can get a local searcher to go to the Parish Church and examine the original registers.

In the Calendars for the Lichfield Consistory Court there are some entries for HARTWELL of Uttoxeter. It was therefore considered that it may be worthwhile to make a search in the BT's for this parish.

A search has been made covering Baptism Marriages Burials from 1668 to 1732 and Baptisms and Marriages from 1733 to 1782.

During the whole of these periods NO MENTION OF THE NAME (or variations of the spelling) was found. It would therefore seem that though the family may have been living in the parish when they made their Wills, they did not use the Parish Church for their family events.

This may be accounted for if they lived near the boundary of the parish and may have found the nearest church was in a nearby parish.

ADDITIONS, CORRECTIONS AND COMMENTS: The following are extracts from letters received from Mrs. Dorothy Warren and pertain to material previously published in the Gazettes:

I have checked Odell [Woodhall] Register (printed copy) against my own extracts and confirm what I said in my letter of the 18th February (see page 117). I also discovered another omission which I failed to mention in the same letter. This was:

1781 19 June Joseph H widr and Eliz. How. M. 16th March 1968

Mr. Harris has sent me a copy of your letter to Mr. Coker in which you express some reservation about the spelling Hartle, etc. I cannot speak for Worcestershire, but so far as Northants and Bucks are concerned any spelling which sounds like Hartle should be accepted. Hartwell is only five miles from here and I know it is pronounced Hart'ell. Bradwell in Bucks is Brad'ell or Bra'll. These pronunciations are of course gradually dying out with the spread of education. Rothwell is Rowell or Roll; Pattishall--Pashul; Bidwell--Biddle; False Well--Fassell; Fairhill -- Farrel. These spring readily to mind, and I think you may take it for granted that any word ending in well will have the "w" elided. Conversely, some words beginning with a vowel will have a "w" prefixed: Odell and Wodell come to mind. Some words beginning with "w" have it elided such as 'ooman for woman. Wolfhampcote in Warwickshire is Oofencote. Another peculiarity is prefixing a "y" such as Yerl for Earl and Yerby for Erby. Earl has actually got to Leherle locally and is pronounced Lerl. If indixes only are searched many omissions might occur. What rather worries me about Hartwell is the possibility of Artwell being missed. Another worry is Attwell which so far I have not included. Funnily enough this name always seems to have the "w" sounded; I do not recall ever seeing Attell, which contradicts what I said above. My impression is that some clergy when entering names in registers tried to correct the pronunciation of the parties and in so doing may have altered the original name. I have done a considerable amount of work on the name Russell which in Northants was originally Rushall. Both forms survive in the same district, and occasionally the name is entered as Rushwell, but though this may have been the original form, I have found no evidence to support it.

Further to my letter of the 16th March. I have now re-checked Cranfield Register (ts copy) and have found two items which I missed in my original hasty search, and which were also missed from the Gazette, viz:

1622 5 May Nich H and MARY ROBINSON married 1642/3 29 Jan Josuah (sic) s of Rd H chr.

I am very sorry to tell you that I discovered that I had made two errors. I feel there was some excuse owing to the haste with which I did the search and the way in which the entries are arranged. This register was copied during the War when paper was rationed and in order to include as much as possible the marriages were arranged in two parallel columns close together, and it now seems that it is necessary to read straight across the two columns instead of down each column separately as would be done in a printed book. Without going into more detail I will just say that I was misled and consequently assigned the wrong year to the entries. The date of Francis H's second marriage was 1616 as Ashcroft said, and the date of Thos. H. to Agnes STUDD was 1610 (not 1609 as in the Gazette or 1613 as I said)....With regard to Pavenham there is a slight correction which I did not mention previously as I was not sure about my own note. 1789 Mar. 29, William Ball not Bell as in Gazette

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
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
